## CSF Officials Training and Certification Pathway

### Officials Level I

- Take Officials Training Course Level 1 = Official Level I: **Trained** status (allows a person to assist in a variety of roles on the hill at the regional and COST tour event level)
- Officiate at one or more CSF sanctioned Events and have Event TD sign off on Officials Card = **Certified** status.

### Officials Level II (Must be Officials Level 1 Certified)

- Take Officials Course Level II = Official Level II: **Trained** status (allows a person to assist in variety of roles including more senior roles such as chief of gates etc.)
- Following the training, the Official will then be required to achieve the following criteria for certification in each discipline.
- **SBX Certification requirements:** Officiate at 4 events, at least 1 COST Level event and at least 2 Regional CSF Sanctioned events. **Officiating at each event must be done in a different leadership role each time.**
- **Alpine Certification requirements:** Officiate at 1 COST Level event and 2 Regional CSF Sanctioned event. **Officiating at each event must be done in a different leadership role each time.**
- **HP/SS certification requirements:** Officiate at 1 COST Level event and 2 Regional CSF Sanctioned event. **Officiating at each event must be done in a different leadership role each time.**

### Officials Level III (Must be Officials Level 2 Certified in each discipline)

- Take Officials Course Level III: this course will be offered once a year at the Snowboard TD update Weekend
- To achieve Level III certification the Official must have completed all Jury Positions in each discipline as well as having Officiated at the World Cup Level and Canadian National Championships.
- They Must be a Canadian Event TD
- Must show a strong working knowledge of the FIS Rule Book and support their decisions within the FIS Rule Book
