It is the Team Manager's primary responsibility to liaise between the Canada Games Mission Staff and the AOS, coaches, athletes and parents to ensure effective planning leading up to the games and provide support to the coaches and athletes at the Games.

The candidate will be responsible for communication on an on-going basis with Team Ontario's Mission Staff leading up to the Canada Games, ensuring effective communication with athletes, coaches and parents of the Canada Games Team, ensuring Team uniforms are fit to athletes and distributed, ensuring that all travel plans and reservations are carried forth for the Canada Games athletes and coaches, providing support to Ontario athletes and coaches at the Canada Games and effectively review and make recommendations for future games.
